**BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE ALTERNATIVE MODE OF PROCUREMENT
UNDER NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT –EMERGENCY PURCHASE DUE TO EFFECTS
OF ENHANCED SOUTHWEST MONSOON (HABAGAT) INTENSIFIED BY TYPHOON
FABIAN IN MINDORO PROVINCES**

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021 an Enhanced Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) intensified by Typhoon Fabian has greatly affected the Mindoro Provinces resulted to massive flooding landslides, destruction of agricultural fields and fisheries and damage to properties and infrastructure ;

WHEREAS, three municipalities in Oriental and Occidental Mindoro were placed under State of Calamity due to impact brought by the said Habagat as strengthened by Typhoon Fabian;

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2021, the Bids and Awards Committee through its Secretariat received an approved Purchase Request for the Emergency Purchase of the Pre-packed Food Items amounting to Two Million Nine Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos Pesos (Php 2,940,000.00) as augmentation support for the victims of the said typhoon;

WHEREAS, Section 53 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184 provides that the Negotiated Procurement –Emergency Cases is a method of procurement of Goods, Consulting Services and Infrastructure Projects whereby the Procuring Entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally and financial capable supplier, contractor or consultant in any of the following cases:

- a. In case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or;
- b. When the time is of the essence arising from natural or man- made calamities or;
- c. Other causes where immediate action is necessary;
 1. to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or
 2. to restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities.


WHEREAS, there is urgency to address and respond for the relief operations for the affected areas in the Region;


WHEREAS, considering that the underlying reason relates to “**time element**”, the BAC finds that adopting Negotiated Procurement –Emergency Purchase is proper and justified ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in light of the foregoing considerations, **WE**, the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it hereby **RESOLVED**:

1. To forward this resolution to the Head of the Procuring Entity, Regional Director, **FERNANDO R. DE VILLA JR., CESO III** to recommend for his approval to resort to Negotiated Procurement –Emergency Cases the procurement of pre-packed food items for the relief operations for the Typhoon Fabian;
2. To authorize the BAC or the End User unit or the Procurement Section to directly negotiate with a legally, technically, and financially capable supplier for procurement undertaken through any of the allowable instances of Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) under Section 53.2 of the 2016 revised IRR and Item V(D) (2a) of Annex “H” of the same IRR;
3. To recommend to the HOPE to supplement the Annual Procurement Plan to cover the Procurement Project that will be resorting to Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) under Section 53.2 of the 2016 revised IRR and Item V (D) (2a) of Annex “H” of the same IRR subject to the validation by the appropriate office in the Procuring Entity that there are funds in the budget to cover for the same.




