

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SLP Elilibility Requirements



Poor, marginalized, vulnerable and/or disadvantaged households, identified by the National Household targeting System for Poverty Reduction (NHTS-PR), prioritizing 4Ps participants.



MD Track participants must be at least sixteen (16) years old to participate with legal consent from parents or guardian, while EF Track participants must be at least eighteen (18) years old



Each household can enroll a maximum of two (2) members pursuing two (2) different tracks — MD through resource-based and market-driven sustainable microenterprises; and EF.

SLP Tracks and Modalities The program has two (2) tracks:



Micro-enterprise Development Track (MD)

focuses on the establishment of micro-enterprise through provision of financial capital, enhancement of skills, and building/ rebuilding physical and natural assets.



(Q) Employment Facilitation Track (EF)

provides assistance to qualified members of poor households who preferred employment rather than engaging in micro-enterprise.



Year 1: Punla

This year can be equated to seed planting, wherein the DSWD-SLP carefully prepares and cultivates the program participants with the basic knowledge and skills in starting up their own micro-enterprises or in securing an employment.



Year 2: Usbong
