# Peace and Development Program

The National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict (NTF-ELCAC) was formed pursuant to Executive Order No. 70 Issued by President Rodrigo Duterte which institutionalized the government's "whole-of-nation" approach in tackling the ongoing communist rebellion in the Philippines led by the Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) and its armed wing, the New People's Army (NPA). The "whole-of-nation" approach is contrasted to prior policy which favored irregular peace talks with communist rebels.

On its effort to prioritize welfare concerns the DSWD Office of the Undersecretary for Inclusive-Sustainable Peace and Special Concerns leads in the implementation of the Peace and Development - Buong Bansa Mayapa Program which focuses on securing the welfare of Communist Terrorist Groups, (CTGs), former members of the different armed groups and children in situations of armed conflict. It also emphasizes the prevention, rehabilitation, and reintegration of social protection and welfare programs for Former Rebels, Former Violents Extremists and their families as well as the recovery and rehabilitation of Conflict Vulnerable Areas


